DCFC asks that parents and their guests attending games, tournaments and events help us by reflecting these character traits at games.

6. I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect and decency.
7. I will teach my child to play by the spirit of the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
8. If I am notified of my child's failure to respect others, I will counsel my child.



9. I will teach my child that commitment to a team requires regular attendance at practice and games, and will also do my best to ensure consistent attendance.
10. I will refrain from vocalizing my dissatisfaction with a coaching or referee's decision. I will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place about any concerns.
11. I will recognize the importance of our team volunteers.

- Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or member of club.
- Written warning.
- Parental suspension from game with written documentation of incident.
- Parental suspension for the season.
